

BOSTON MASSACRE

By the year 1768 British officials in London had decided it was time to show the colonies that they meant to control them. The Boston colonists were angered at this move and looked upon the British troops as enemies. Captain Thomas Preston, commander of the troops rushed out shouting to his men not to fire. The troops were ordered back to their barracks. This incident in which the rioters were mainly at fault was the first important

expression of anti-British feeling and a demand for American Independence.
